Grower Champagne is an, ironically, growing category, and it's about freaking time! We spotlight a number of Champagnes that take their singular science involved in sparkling wine (IE cooking vs. baking, no such thing as a lil' pinch of baking soda) (unless you enjoy unleavened bread) (or cleaning yeast off the walls of your kitchen) and combine it with fastidious farming procedures, melding the earth and the science, creating - what exactly? - experiences that sparkle in a different fashion, taking the mental in experimental and turning it into stars that Dom Perignon never saw coming. - Grower **AND** Showers.

Here we go again, mixing white wines with red wines (not to mention metaphors with similes), but Sanguis' owner/winemaker Mattias Pippig does the same thing with many of these, so I feel justified (and while we're at it, 'Justified' is the best show on the scary hypnotic box and Timothy Olyphant the best performer on a show embarrassingly rich with great acting); these wines stand on their own as paragons of anything and everything that makes wine special, and the public's need to label and compare will always fall short when faced with the mercurial mix of genius, courage, experimentation and madness evidenced by Pippig & visionaries of his ilk (few that they are); there is precious little Sanguis produced (typically less than 150 cases of any given release), and we feel fortunate to be in on the ground floor of what promises to be a high-powered thrill ride into the future (with more than a nod to the distant past) of winemaking (and wine drinking) as we know it...cheers!

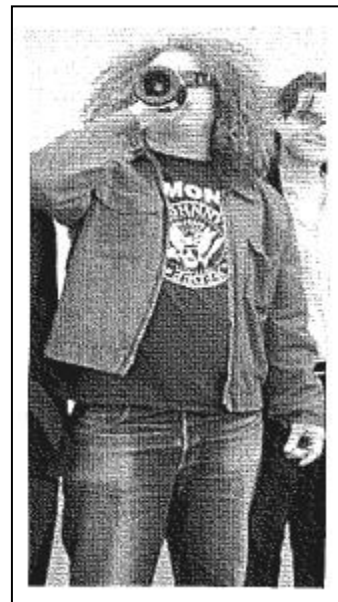

I looked up "gothic hell" in the dictionary yesterday I swear one of these labels was pictured! - but, then again, so was my childhood, so if you were still trying to decipher the "why" behind the list, there's a clue.)
